### Option A: “Life as an SLP researcher” (Theresa Bloder & Tanja Rinker)

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In Workshop 1 on personal career development, questions regarding the career of (future) PhD students and postdoctoral researchers will be discussed. The two facilitators will give a short personal presentation of their ways into research. Following this, the workshop will cover topics like creating a research profile, establishing collaborations, potential (postdoctoral) career paths and different options for grant applications.

After a short introduction the following topics will be covered:

1. During your PhD - life as a PhD student, work-life-balance, applying for postdoc positions, networking (nationally and internationally);
2. A mentor’s perspective - applying for a PhD, view on career paths and funding options, networking (nationally and internationally).

### Option B: “How to disseminate, communicate and sell my research effectively” (Juhayna Taha)

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In Workshop 2, the focus will be on the importance of making research evidence accessible and visible to potential users. A distinction will be made between sharing research findings with clinicians, the scientific community and policy makers versus communicating research to the general public. The workshop will provide tips to students/researchers on how to use social media to market themselves, promote their research and build research collaborations/connections.
